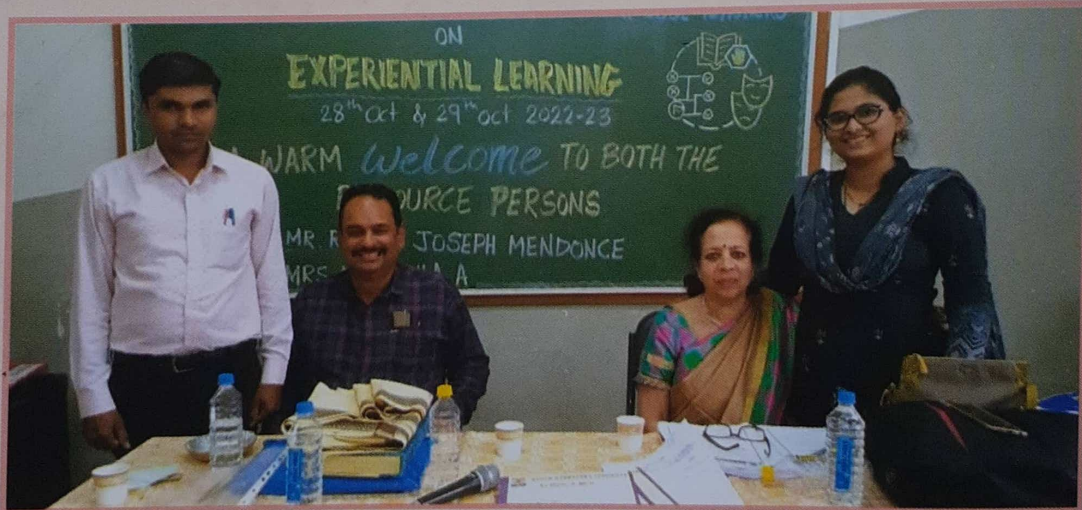

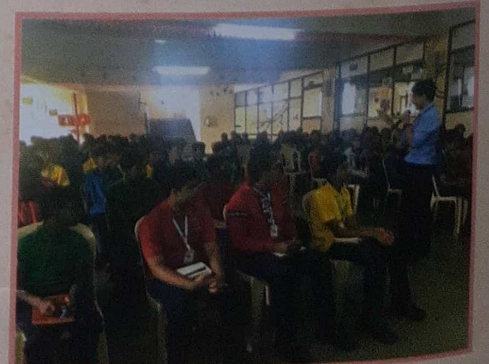
## TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAM

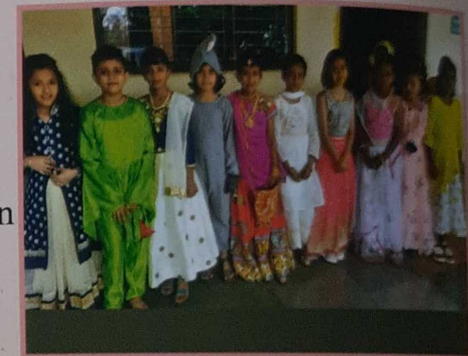
### ➤ **Rastriya Ekta Diwas – Run For Unity**

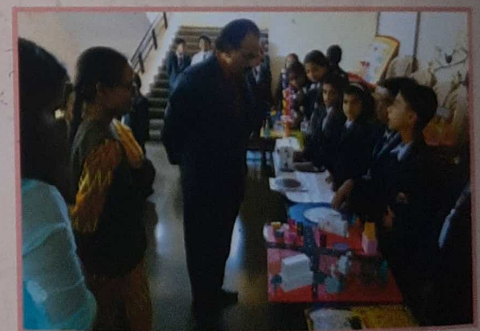
### ➤ **Children's Day**

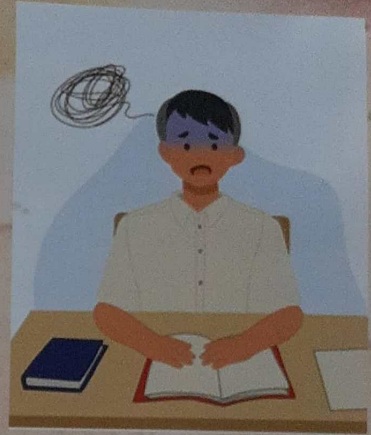
### One can implement women's empowerment through

7. Start early revision: An early revision will help you complete the study for the exam before time.

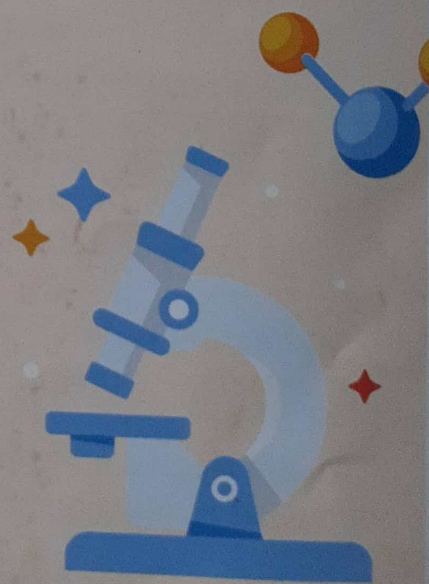
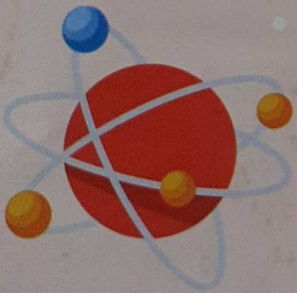

## ASTERIODS



Asteroids are the rubble left over from the solar system's formation roughly 4.6 billion years ago. Scientists estimate that more than a million of these itty-bitty worlds orbit the sun in the Asteroid Belt, stretch of space between Mars and Jupiter.

In 1801, while making a star map Giuseppe Piazzi accidentally discovered a small object 1000 kilometres (600 miles) in diameter between the orbits of Mars and Jupiter. He named the object Ceres. It was the first asteroid to be discovered.

Asteroids are formed by dust particles in the early solar system collided, forming larger clumps, known as planetesimals. If the asteroid hits on land, there would be a huge amount of dust thrown up into the atmosphere. At present, it is travelling about 85,000 miles per hour (138,000 kilometres per hour) relative to the Sun.

Nasa crashed a space craft into the asteroid Dimorphos on Sept. 26, 2022. The small near-Earth asteroid, called 2023 BU, zipped over the southern tip of South America at 7: 27p.m.ET Thursday about 2,200 miles (93,540 kilometres) above Earth's surface. This distance was well within the orbit of global satellites. There was no risk of the asteroid striking Earth, according to Nasa. 27-Jan- 2023.

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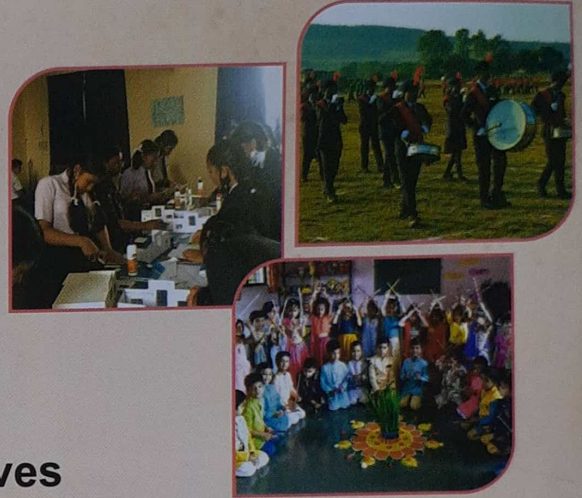
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
